Did you know? The man who wore this hat was given the nickname the Cockatoo Governor. Do you have nickname? What does it say about who you are?



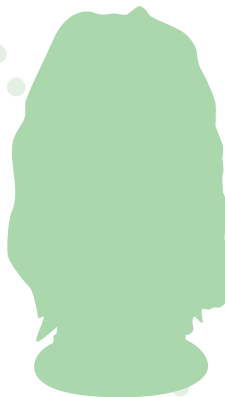

Did you know? Women in South Australia couldn't vote until 1894, more than 50 years after the colony was settled?



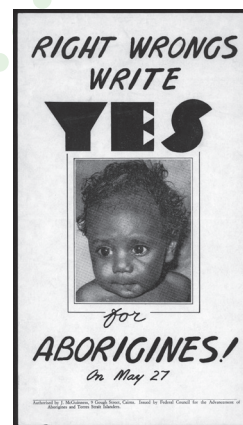
